Minutes of the NTF congress held in Hillerød, Denmark October 19th 2007

1. Opening of the congress

The President opened the congress and thanked Denmark for a well organised congress. Allan Carlsen selected as secretary.

2. Approval of the agenda

The agenda was proved.

3. Ajustment of the protocol from Gjøvik Oct. 2005 and from Copenhagen Sep. 2006

Both protocols where approved.

4. Confirmation of the NTF Activity Report 2005-2007, including financial report.

Benny Johansson og Taisto Kuoppala was elected as President and Vicepresident in 2005. Protocols from 2005 and 2006

Auditor-report from 2005 made by former President Tryggve Duun shows a surplus on Nkr. 9333,-

Auditor-report from 2006 shows a surplus on 1809,- Nkr ? but has a debt to the Norwegian Federation on Nkr. 23187,- for travelling expenses, purchase of cardigans and a technique-barbell.

There are not yet send a bill to those who have received the cardigans and the technique barbell.

Auditor-report from 2007 shows a deficit on 3261, but there are still 2 Nordic Championships to come. Finland and Iceland has not yet paid membercontingent for 2006 and 2007.

Auditor-report for 2007 shows a balance on Nkr. 38243,-. Yvonne Meier asked for a banknote, which could confirm the amount.

5. Proposel

1. Proposal from Sweden: Entry fee for Nordic Masters are changed to one half to NTF and one half to the Organiser. At the moment 150,- SEK each.

The proposal was approved with all votes.

2. Proposal from Sweden: Nordic Championships for Masters are held every second year ó the years where Nordic Seniors are not held.

The proposal was approved with all votes.

3. Proposal from Norway: Not serving alcohol during the banquet and other social activities during the Nordic Championships for youth and juniors.

The proposal was approved but can not stand alone. Every nation must bee responsibel and tell their lifters to behave properly.

4. Proposal from Norway: Registration of Nordic Masters records in all IWF's age categories and that is for men M1 to M10 and for women W1 to W7.

The proposal was approved with 2 votes in favour, 1 against and 1 not voting. Sweden only wants to register the agegroups competing in Nordic championships.

Trond Kvilhaug will be the person who registers the records and that means that all the Nordic countries must send their best Masters results to NTF

5. Proposal from Sweden: Election to the NTF board: A person can be elected even if he/she is not a member of his/her national federation.

The proposal was approved with 3 votes and 1 not voting. The person must be nominated by the national federation and only one person from each country can be elected. This must be updated in the rules.

6. Confirmation of the Nordic records.

The records were approved. No comments about the existing records, but remember to send new records to NTF.

7. Nordic Weightlifting Federation rules.

The rules were updated the 1st of October 2007. Trond Kvilhaug has done a tremendous job. We send thanks to Trond Kvilhaug.

The Icelanders had booked their own hotel and not used Hotel Hillerød arranged by the Danish Federation. Therefore the congress approved a new rule. The participating lifters in the Nordic championships must use the hotel the arranging Federation has chosen.

This must also be written in the invitation.

Anders B. Nielsen from Denmark told us about the work with adjusting results for the NTF Elite Pin. It would be best if we can use the adjusted results from 2008 and if anyone has comments to the new rules, please bring this up in the congress in Landskrona in November 2007.

The president and the vicepresident will adjust the Nordic Rules to be approved on the congress in 2008.

8. Elections.

- NTF president: Benny Johansson, Sweden was elected for 2 years.
- NTF vicepresident: Per Mattingsdal, Norway was elected for 2 years.
- NTF General secretary: Håkon Johansson, Sweden (not present) was elected for 2 years.
- NTF Executive board: Each nation has only one vote. John Mørch, Denmark and Essi Lomma, Finland and Armanda Arransson, Iceland and Magnus Kjellgren, Sweden. Norway will find a person.

9. Honorary medals.

No proposals.

10. Nordic championships 2008.

Nordic youth and juniors championships: no information yet.

Nordic Masters: 15th of November in Copenhagen.

11. Nordic championships 2007 (Hillerød).

Schedule with transport times from hotel to competition hall and the other way.

Mealtickets and Banquet ticket was given to each nation.

Saturday: Weigh in for women in room 28 at the hotel from 10.00-11.00. For men in the congressroom from 10.00-11.00.

Sunday: Weigh in for men in the congressroom from 09.00-10.00.

Openingceremoni Saturday: from 11.45. 10 min break between snatch and clean and jerk in each group. 15 min break between the groups.

Confirmation on starting lists ó lists where confirmed

All women and men cat. 56 ó 77 kg on Saturday and men 85 - +105 Sunday.

Examination of referee Timo Kuukonen from Cat. II to Cat. I.

Appoint of the technical officials. Jury are Benny Johansson, Per Mattingsdal, Poul Meier and Flemming Kiel.

4 Confirmation of Nordic records

Mr Trond Kvilhaug will continue the registration of new Nordic records. A completion of the date of birth to the list of masters records shall be done and have reference to all masters categories.

5 NTF Honorary Medals: Proposals?

There were no proposals to NTF Honorary Medals. Mr President urged the congress to apply for the Honorary Medals.

6 Nordic Championships 2008

A) Junior- and youth Championships: Finland organise the championships. Place/venue is not yet selected.

B) Masters Championships: Denmark organise the championships at Copenhagen, November 15th. Mr President urged the nations to participate with more athletes.

7 Nordic Referee Conference (Landskrona)

The referee conference started at Friday and will continue Saturday morning. All referees will work as technical officials during the Championships.

8 Nordic Junior- and youth Championships 2007, Landskrona

A) Statement by the organizing committee:

The president of Landskrona AK, Patrik Helgesson, informed on transportation matters. A big bus will transport athletes and technical officials to the venue after the weigh in both days, and back to the hotel after the competition. A minibus will go from the venue to hotel at 13.00, 15.00 and 17.00.

Breakfast at 07.00 ó 10.00, lunch at 12.00 ó 14.00, banquet 20.00 at the hotel.

Opening ceremony: Every nation participates with two women, two men and a standard-bearer. The participants will meet in the warm up area at 11.40.

Competition: The presentation will start immediately after the last lift of the former group. 10 minutes break after the presentation. Prize ceremony after the presentation. 10 minutes break between snatch and clean & jerk.

Sauna at the hotel from 09.00 at Saturday.

B) Examination of referees.

There will be no examination of referees during the championships.

C) Confirmation of the starting list

The congress approved to the starting list after some changes.

D) Appointment of officials

Technical officials will work in two groups.

Jury president: Benny Johansson

Jury member: Per Mattingsdal

Jury member: Fleming Skov

Weigh in referee Saturday: Tina Beiter, Per Marstad and a Swedish referee.

Female lifters start the weigh in.

E) Any other business

- Mrs Eva Helgesson will be chief of the competition venue.
- Benny Johansson explained how the course of the competition using the competitor card works.

9 Any other business

A) The stipulation of the NTF Elite pins proposed by Anders B Nielsen, Denmark was approved. Nielsen has put a lot of care on this work. The new stipulation will be valid from 01.01.2008.

B) Tryggve Duun former president of NTF, has been elected as an extra member of the NTF board by the Norwegian Weightlifting Federation.

C) Nordic coaching conference with support from IWF and a specialist lecturer is to be hold in Sweden at Eleikosport Equipment, Halmstad. First conference will be from Thursday to Sunday, preliminary date February 2008. Three coaches from each Nordic nation will be invited.

1 Opening of the congress

The congress delegates were welcomed by the NTF President, Benny Johansson hoping for a smooth running congress. Then he gave some news from Iceland.

Håkan Johanson was appointed secretary for the congress.

2 Approval of the agenda

It was decided that item 8 moved up between item 5 and 6. The agenda was approved with this correction.

3 Adjustment of the minutes from Landskrona (Nov. 2007)

The minutes were approved.

4 Confirmation of the Nordic records

The NTF President urged the federations to use a record form, the same as the Swedish WF use. A copy of the record form will be sent to NTF member federations by General Secretary.

Finland reminds the congress to correct a female lifter's name. It shall be **Heidi Harju**. A new list will be sent to Trond Kvilhaug from Finland with correct names.

No other change of records was proposed.

5 NTF Honorary Medals: proposals?

There were no proposals, but Finland will send proposals later on behalf of the 75th anniversary of the Finnish Weightlifting Federation. Benny Johansson informed the delegates of the 100 year anniversary of the Swedish WF as a federation since 1909.

8 Proposals to the congress

8.1 Nordic Championships/senior every year (Norway)

Norway propose that the Nordic Championships seniors should be organized every year. The delegates of Norway pointed out that only a few lifters from each Nordic federation participate at the World Championships. It is important for many lifters to have the possibility of participating yearly at Nordic Championships seniors.

Denmark was not interested of yearly Nordic Ch. Seniors because of too small numbers of lifters.

Finland and Sweden was of the same opinions as Norway. To the proposal was added a new category, under 23, to be hold together with Nordic Ch. Seniors.

Decicion: *The congress decided that Nordic Championships will be organized yearly including the new category, under 23. It will be valid from 2009.*

8.2 Nordic Team Championships/club competition (Denmark)

Anders Bendix Nielsen reported on a suggestion how to organize Nordic League. It should be included in the Nordic Championships seniors. Denmark was however not much interested in this kind of competition due to a small numbers of lifters in Denmark.

Norway, Finland and Sweden were interested. The proposal was discussed focusing on the numbers of lifters in the teams. Sweden proposed 4 men and 3 to count, 3 women and 2 to count.

Decicion: *The Nordic Championships will include the Nordic Team Championships for clubs. Each team will consist of maximum 4 men, 3 to count and 3 women, 2 to count. The lifters have to live in the Nordic country where the club is situated.*

6 Organizer of the Nordic Championships: New schedule (proposal)

A new schedule for organizers of Nordic Championships was proposed by Per Mattingsdal, Norway, including Senior and Junior/Youth championships 2009 to 2012.

Denmark pointed out that the calendar 2009 already was decided, but they should make a try to incorporate the Junior/Youth championships.

Decicion: *The schedule of the forthcoming Nordic Championships as presented above was accepted by all federations. Senior Championships will be organized in September and Junior/Youth Championships in October.*

After the speaches the presentation of the lifters and referees will be carried out.

- B) Examination referee: Tina Beiter, Denmark will be examined to category II referee during the competition.
- C) The congress determined the starting list of the competition. Changes of categories will not be accepted after the congress has been completed!
- D) Appointment of technical officials: Benny Johansson and Per Matningsdal were appointed to make referee schedules.
- E) Any other business: There was no other business.
