#### b) Confirmation of Starting list

After a discussion how to divide the competitors into groups, it was decided that all youth and one women junior group compete at Saturday. Two groups of women junior and all the men junior compete at Sunday. In this way the Conference did take in consideration how the athletes has planned there arrivals.

#### c) Examination of referees

There was no proposals to examine referees.

#### d) Appointment of technical officials

The refereeø participation at the referee conference will serve in different positions during the two days. Mrs. Tina Beiter, Denmark, will be responsible for the referee schedule.
