6 Proposals to the Congress

The NTF President and General Secretary proposed an updated version of the NTF Rules. It was mostly updated according to the congress decisions in Pori and Stavanger. Everything was approved but the article 8:u and article 12. They remain unchanged.

7 Confirmation of the Nordic Records

The congress decided that from now on, NTF will not produce record list for the category U23 and Masters.

Finland Proposes *Milko Tokola* for Elite Pin. Milko made 305 kg in category 77 kg 14.4.2012 in Antalya.

Finland orders a new Elite Pin for Jari Hirvonen, who has lost his, no 65.
